We are members of the Manitoba Highland Dancers' Association, a non-profit organization of volunteers whose goal is to preserve the Scottish heritage in Manitoba through Highland Dance. We accomplish this goal by holding 6 competitions every year and several performances at various public events such as the Tartan Day and Folklorama.

On the first Saturday of December, every year (going back to the 1970's), we hold a fundraiser called the Tartan Tea. This year, it will be Saturday, December 5 from 1-4pm at Minto Armoury. Everyone in the MHDA participates by donating goods for our prize baskets, baking to be served and for our bake sale, as well as volunteering their time.

If your company is able to assist with a donation, we have several areas where goods or services could be used. We hold a "Scottish Auction" prize raffle and always require items to include in the prize baskets. We give out door prizes. We serve and sell baking, plus serve coffee and tea to our guests, so we could use any baked goods, plates, cups, napkins or coffee supplies you may be able to provide. We also give a small "goodie bag" to each of the performers, so any treats, trinkets or coupons that can be added to these goodie bags would also be appreciated.
